


### technique

This is the new digital technology developed by Pamesa Grupo Empresarial that transforms ceramic design into a three-dimensional surface with a precision that was previously unattainable. It is not just a simple finish, but a complete system capable of generating textures and volumes that are perfectly integrated with the graphics, giving the ceramics unprecedented realism and expressiveness.

At the heart of Gravita is a set of digital applications that work in harmony with the decoration of the piece.

#### structuring ink

The digital application of special inks creates reliefs through reactions with the enamel. The result is precise, delicate details that provide realistic texture without losing colour definition.



#### mixed combination

The true essence of Gravita: the combination of both processes to obtain sophisticated three-dimensional surfaces. Reliefs of different levels that play with light and shadow, multiplying the visual richness of each design.




#### digital glue + vacuumed grit

An innovation that allows for the creation of larger volumes. The adhesive fixes the grit only in the desired areas, and the excess is removed before firing, achieving surfaces with depth and naturalness.





# modularity and formats



Gravita adapts to the needs of architectural and interior design thanks to a system of modular formats that allow for infinite compositions. The pieces are available in four sizes –120x120, 60x120, 60x60 and 30x60— which integrate harmoniously with each other, offering flexible solutions for floors, walls and customised projects.

The result is a versatile modular language capable of creating dynamic patterns, balanced compositions or sober and uniform distributions. A system designed to facilitate both the creativity of designers and the functionality of installation.





With Gravita, ceramics reach a higher aesthetic level. The precision of its digital applications allows the relief to be integrated with the piece's graphics, achieving surfaces where colour and texture enhance each other.

The combined textures provide a visual richness that transcends simple imitation: the stones look more authentic, the wood grain takes on a natural volume and the cement shows real depth. The relief does not interfere with the colour intensity, ensuring a vibrant and nuanced result.

The result is a ceramic tile capable of conveying realism, sophistication and durability, setting a new standard of quality for architectural and interior design.


### VERSATILITY IN DESIGN









## COLLECTIONS

### MAO

Maó draws inspiration from the sobriety and honesty of Mediterranean cement, a material deeply rooted in the building tradition of the southern basin. It is an unpretentious material, the result of manual labour, the desire to endure and a simplicity that becomes a virtue over time. Its clean, serene and uniform texture conveys stability and calm, reminiscent of the floors, walls and courtyards of those buildings where life passes slowly, almost motionless, under the intense light of the Mediterranean.








# **GADAQUES**








## IRTA

Irta stems from a reinterpretation of campaspero, a light-coloured, resistant and honest limestone that has been part of Mediterranean architecture for centuries. Its simple and noble character connects with a way of building that respects both the environment and the memory of the territory, where materials are not just a technical choice, but a testimony to culture. This stone speaks of walls that filter light, cool floors in summer, and courtyards where tranquillity is a way of life.








## SAONA

Saona is inspired by compact, fine-grained granite in which small particles bind together to create a solid, balanced surface. This type of stone connects with the Mediterranean memory of floors and pavements designed to withstand the passage of time, materials created to last, absorb light and age with dignity and without drama. We have reimagined this material using a contemporary language that preserves its natural beauty and gives it the clarity and nuances demanded by today's architecture.
